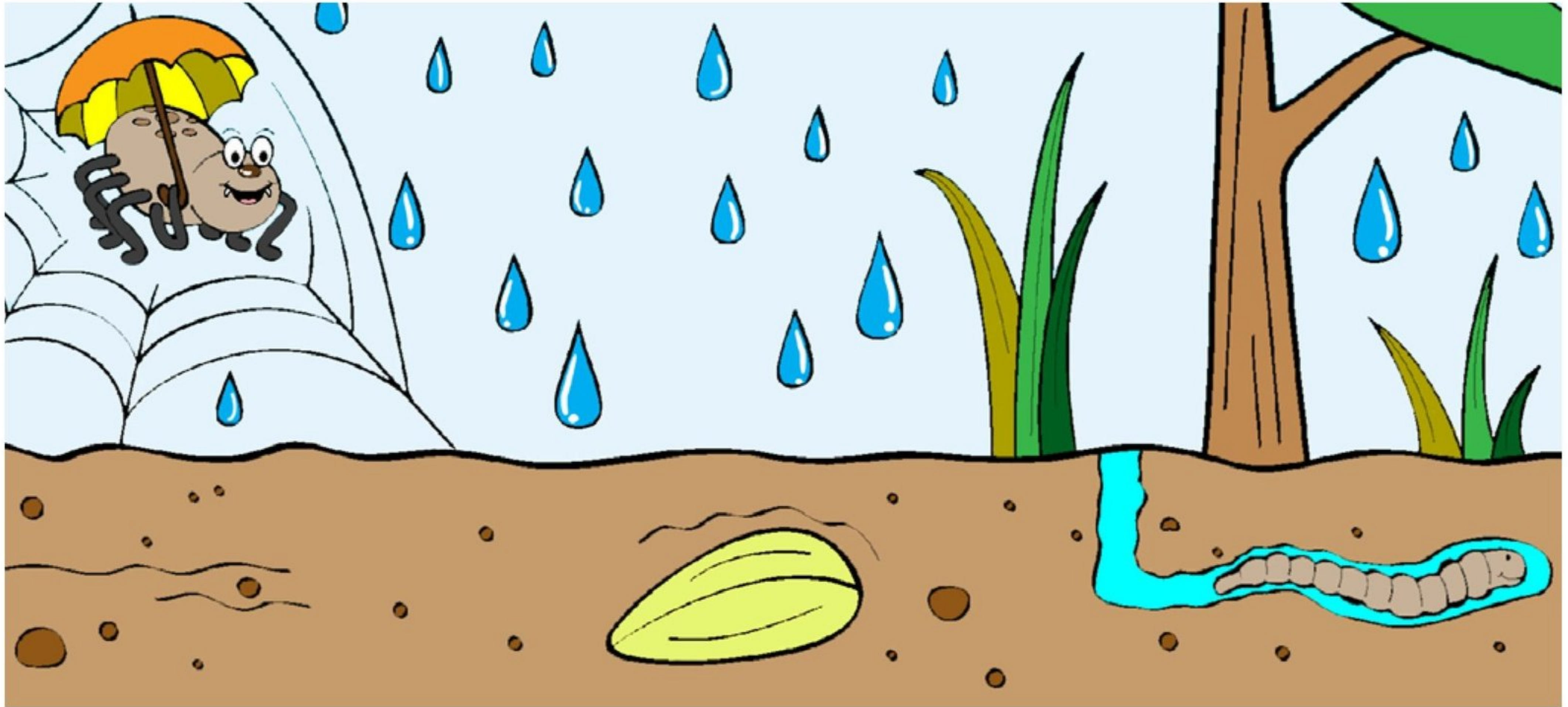

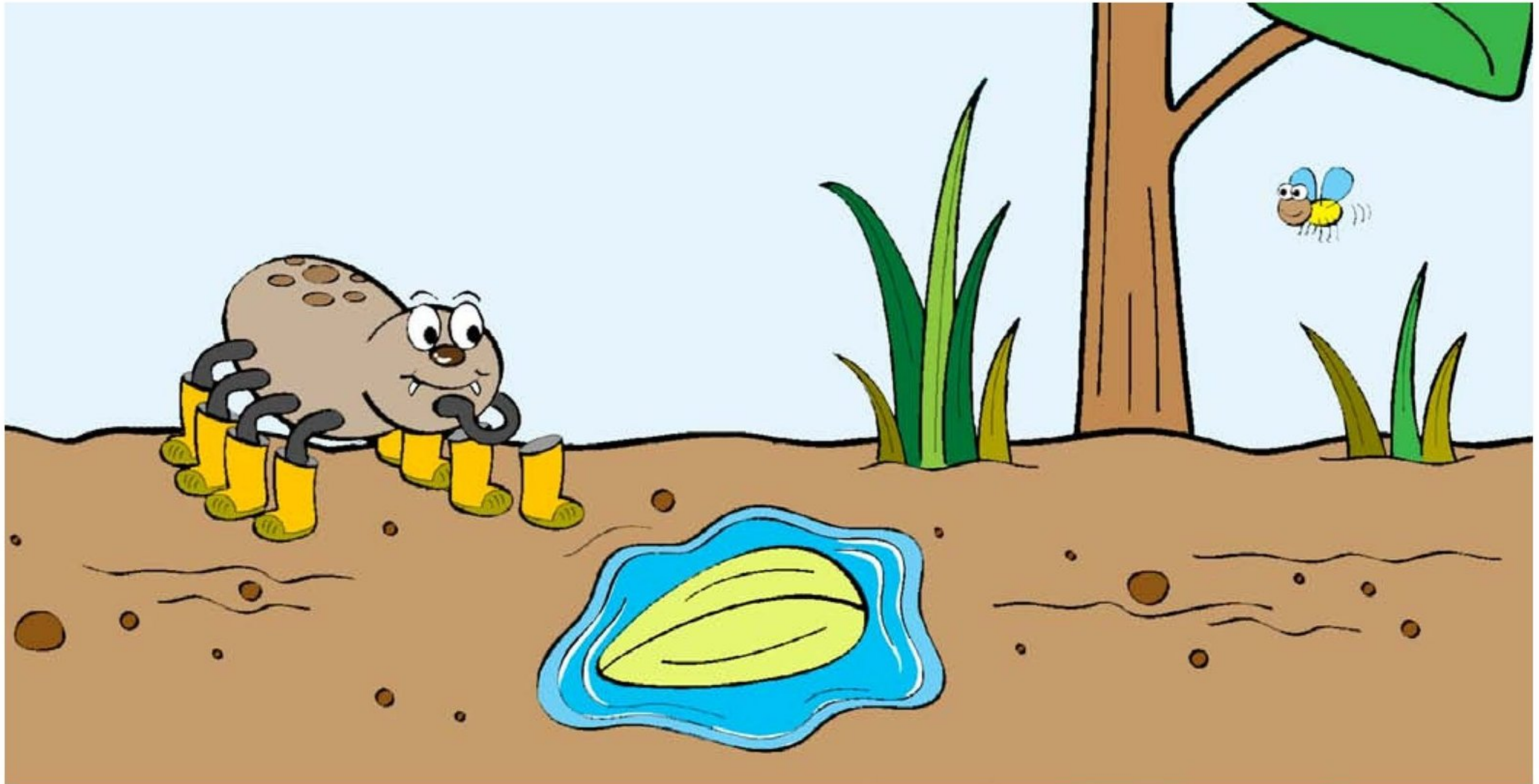
 A small seed falls to the ground
and becomes buried in the soft soil.



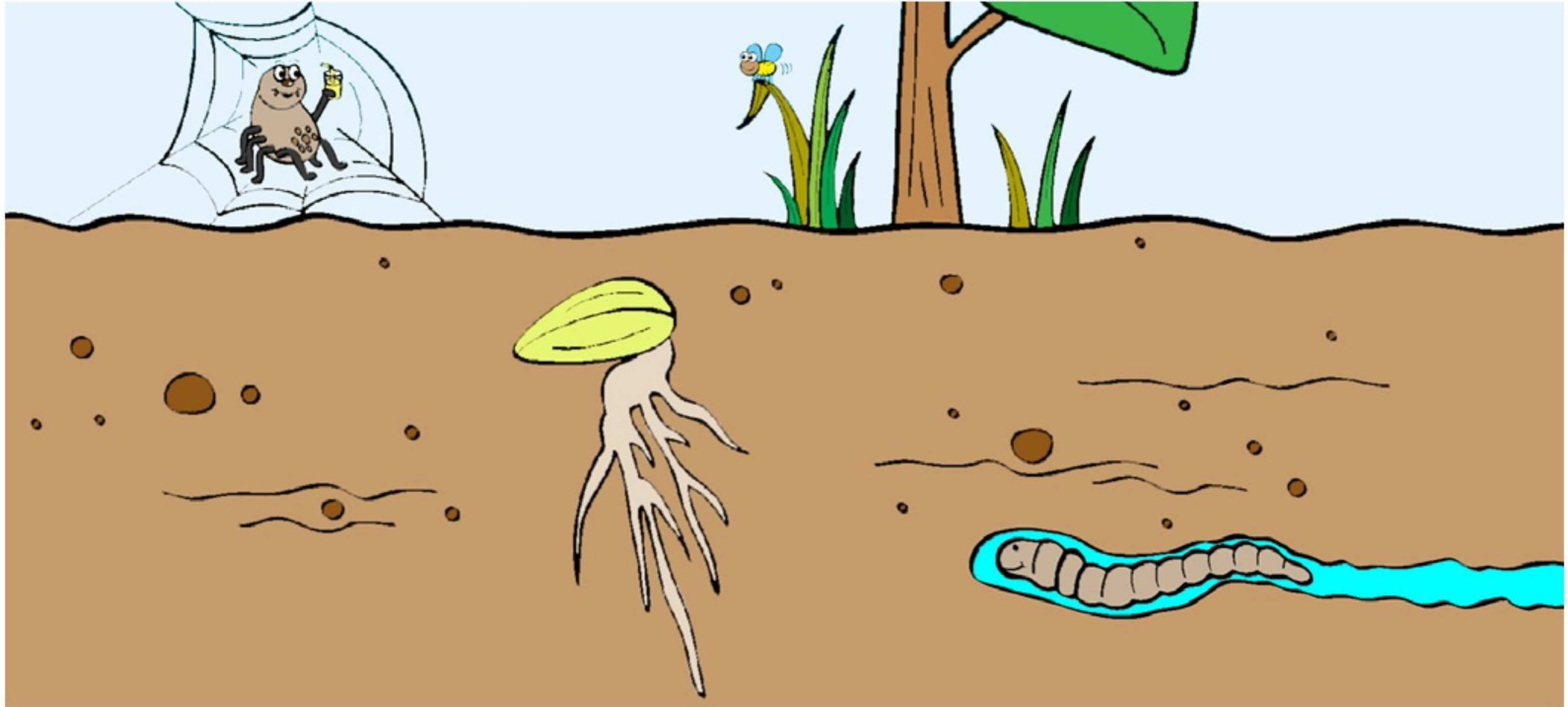
🔊 The seed is buried in the soft soil,
and the rain falls.



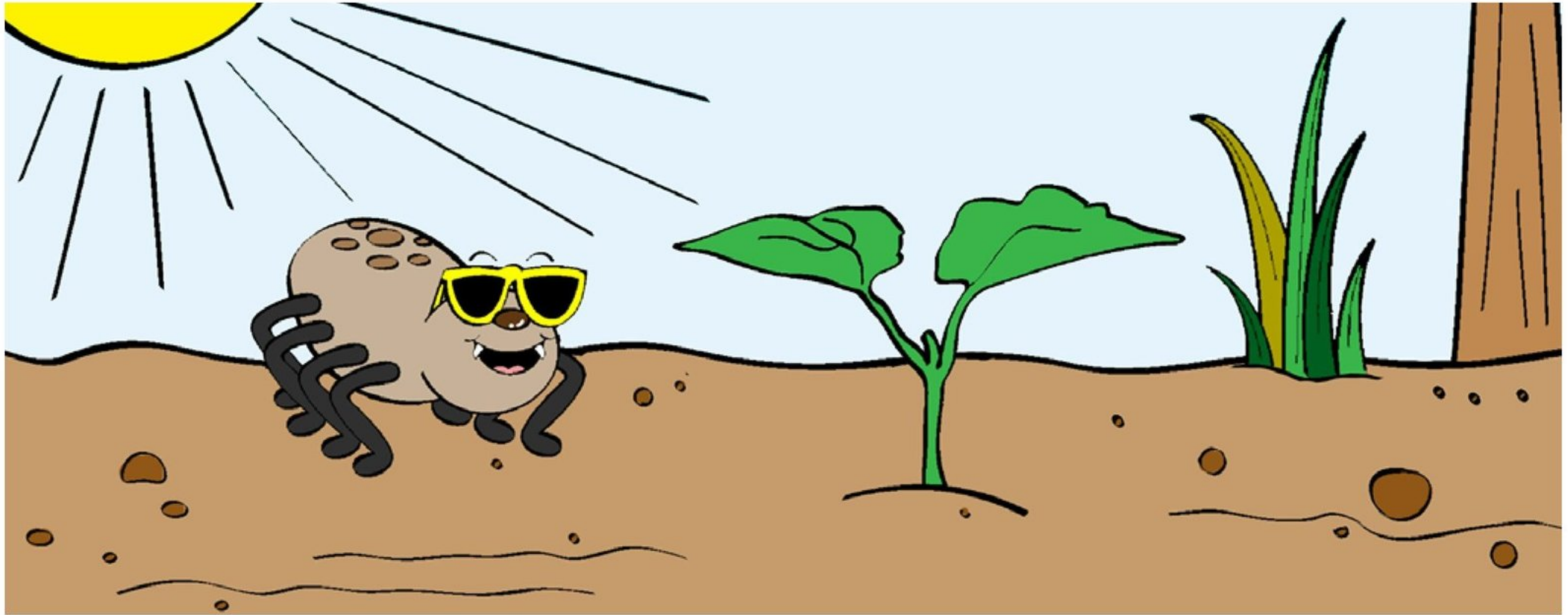
🔊 The rain soaks into the soil that holds the small seed.



 The small seed soaks up water from the rain.



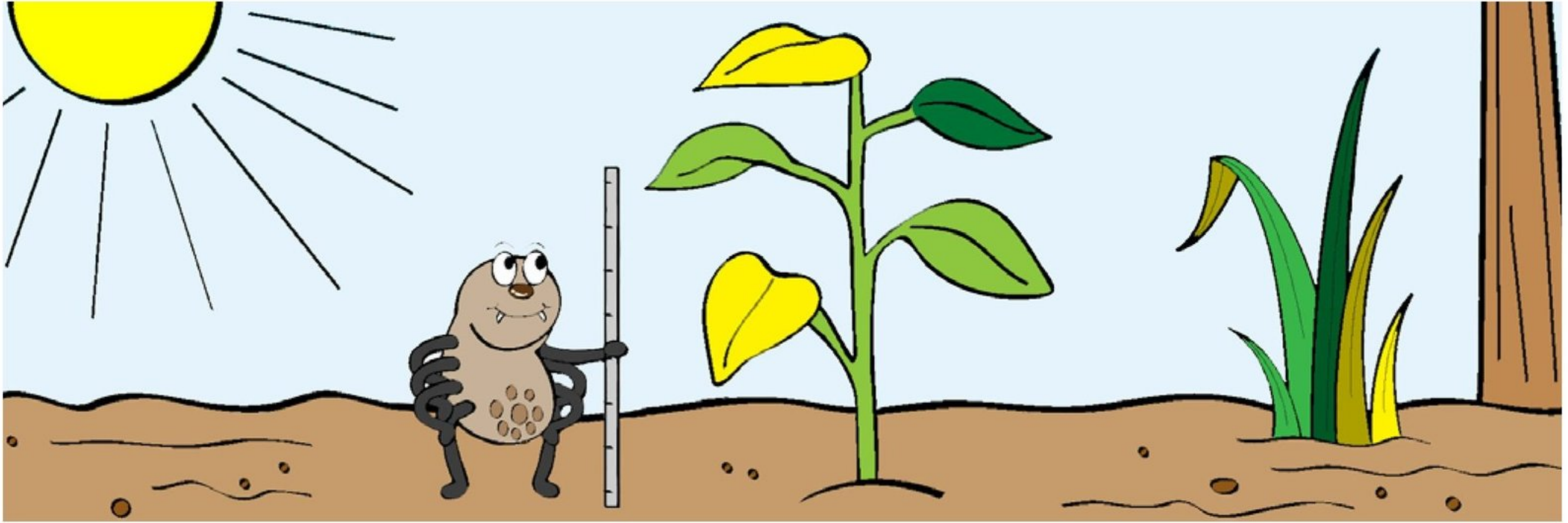
🔊 The water helps the seed,

🔊 The leaves and a stem
grow up through the ground.
The leaves gather in the sunshine.



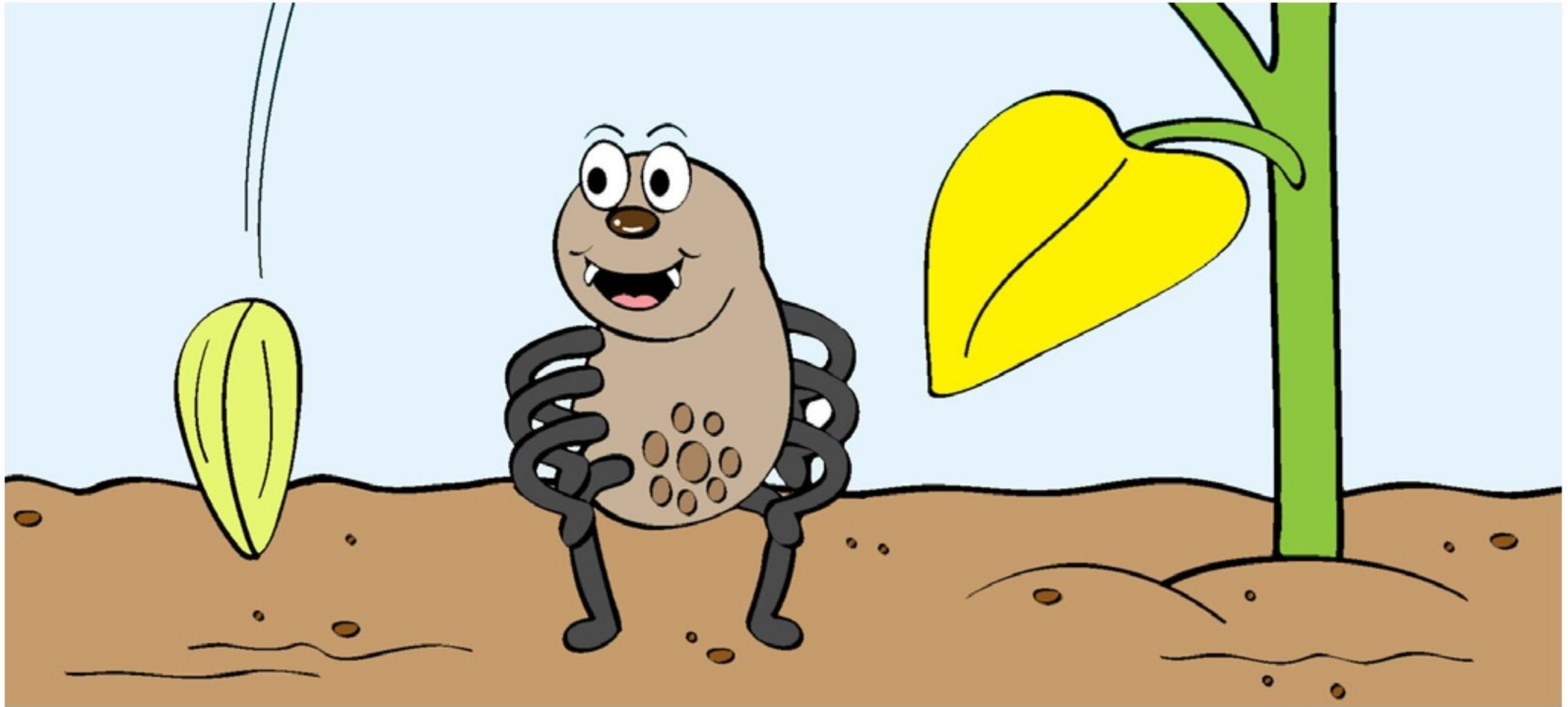
 The plant uses sunshine to make food.
The rain and the soil help the small plant.



🔊 The plant grows taller,
and more leaves grow on the stem.
The roots grow longer.
They go deep in the ground.



 The big plant grows flowers.
The flowers make seeds.
