It is an emperor penguin.





Its beak is long and hooked, and its feathers are white.


It is a pelican.

Its beak is short and sharp, and its feathers are white. It is a chicken.




Its beak is long and flat, and its feathers are brown. It is a mallard duck.




Its beak is long and curved, and its feathers are brown. It is a thrasher.
