“We need more fun.” 🗣️



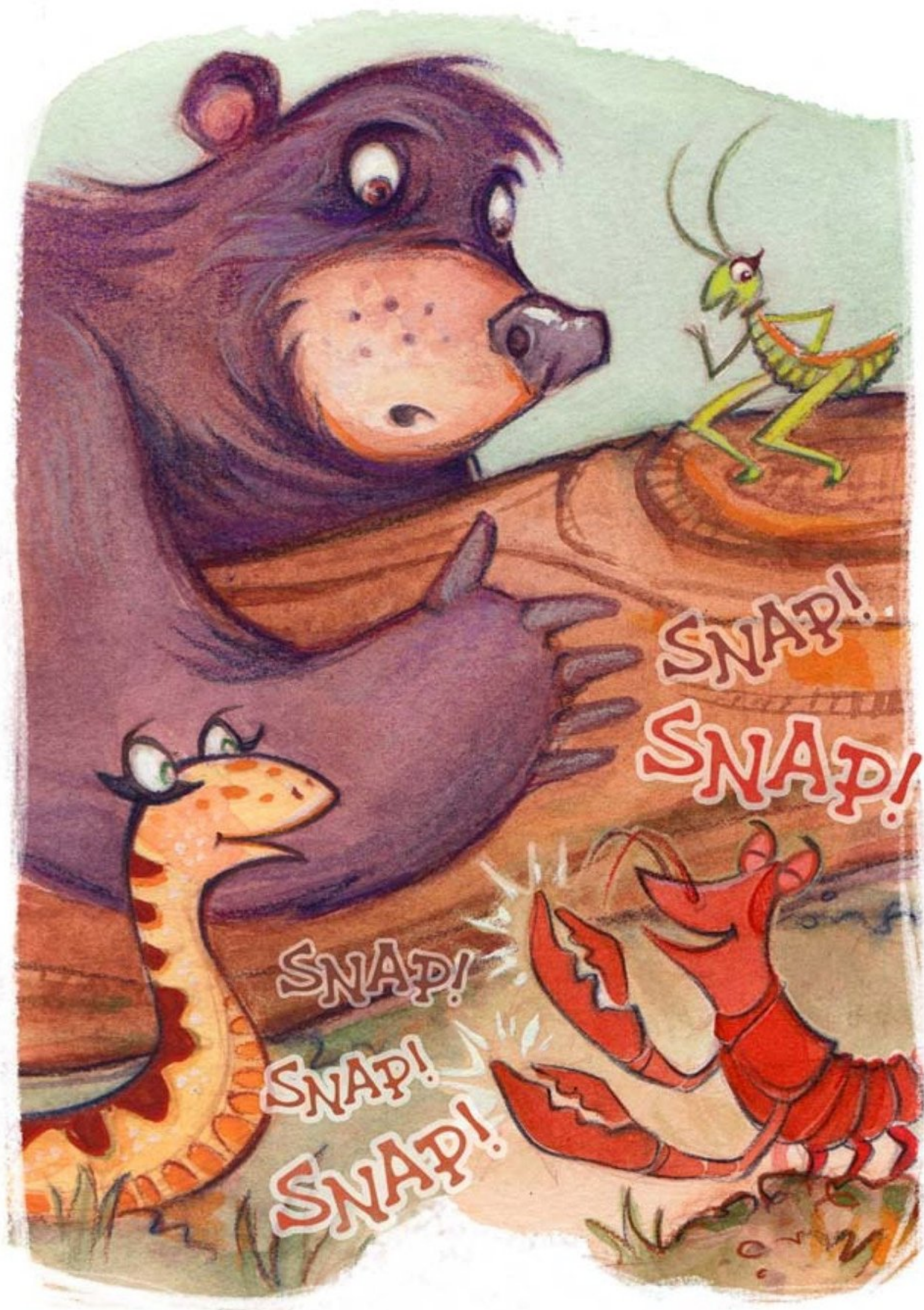
“A band would be fun,”

“They can zing-zing-zing.”

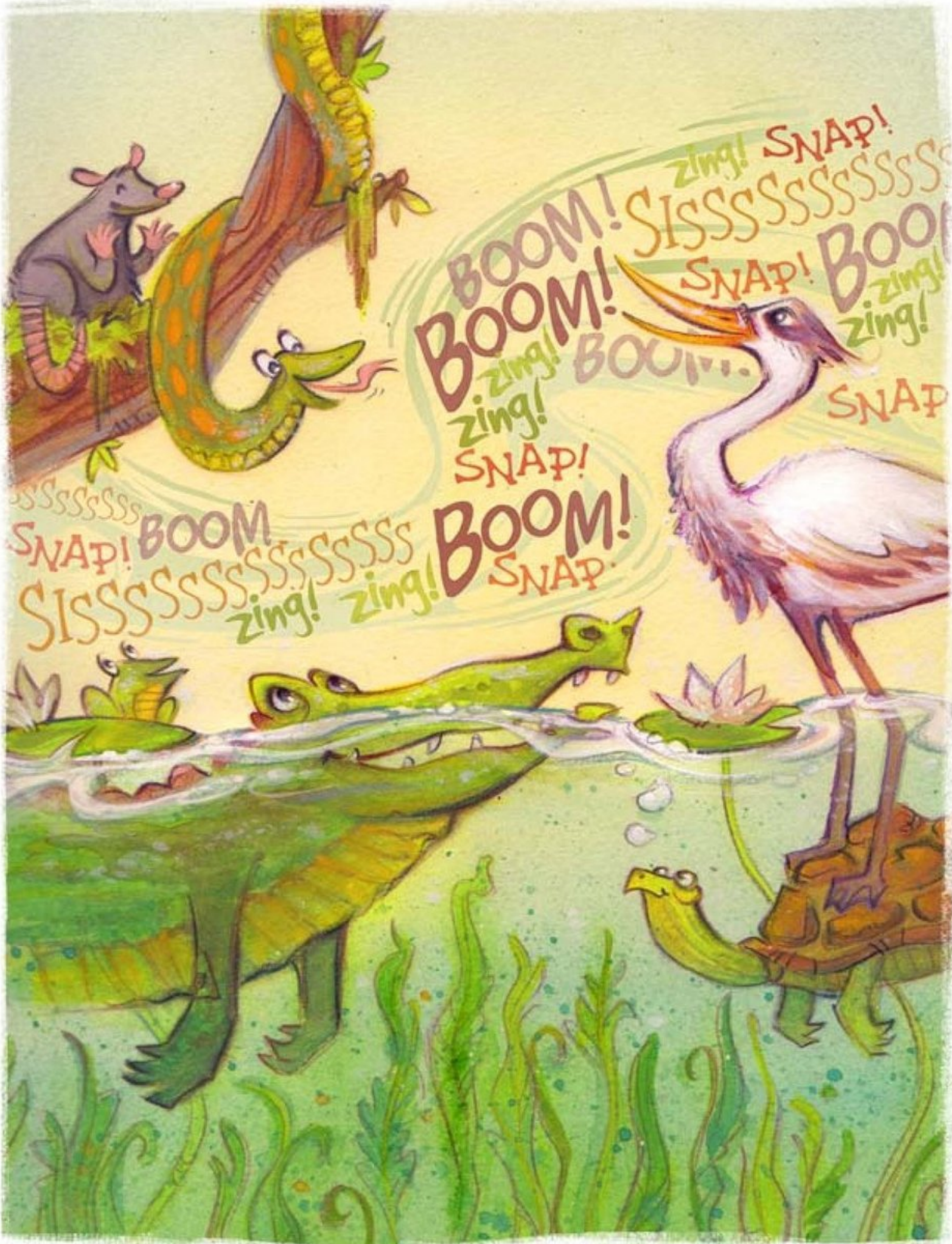




“I can go *sissssss*
