
Zorb wanted to **take over** Earth. "We have **blasters!**" Zorb said.



"Take a deep breath.


Count to ten.

Zorb jumped over his dad. He grabbed the controls of the spaceship.


"You need to learn a **lesson**," his dad said.

He saw some kids playing kickball.




"I am Zorb, the ruler of Earth!" Zorb said.

They looked at Zorb and started to laugh.


"You're just a little kid," a boy said.

He took a deep breath and counted to ten.


"Can I play?" Zorb asked.

No one made fun of him.




A boy rolled the ball.
