




The Queen Ant's Birthday






Today is a big day at the ant nest.

It's the queen ant's birthday!




The ants have many jobs to do before the queen wakes up.

They will work together to surprise her with a party.




Some worker ants clean the nest.

They also find a picnic that has the queen's favorite foods! The ants carry cookies, grapes, and cheese back to the nest.




Back home, the strongest ants guard the nest.


They can use their large jaws to fight.
