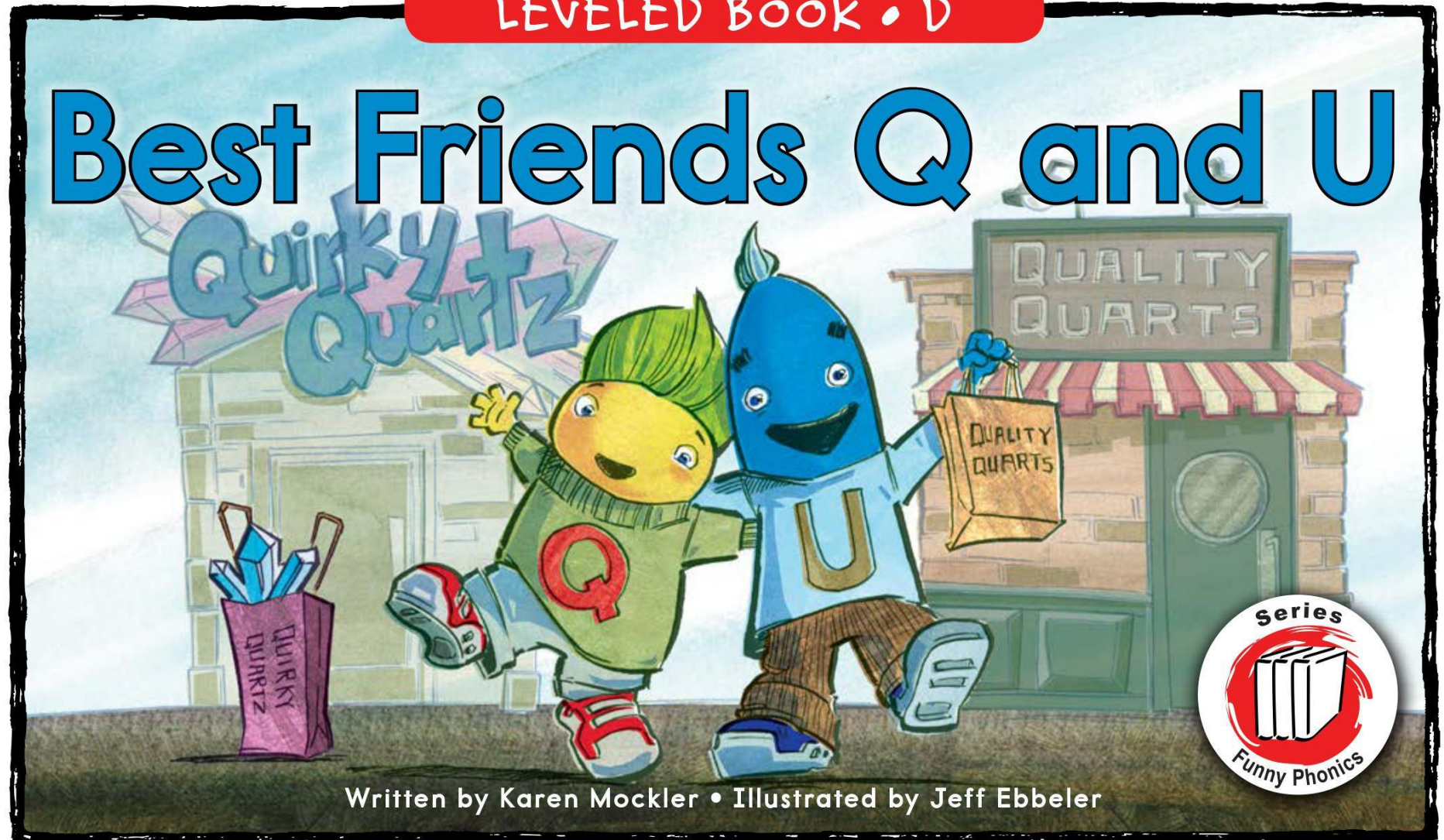

They quack together at some quail.



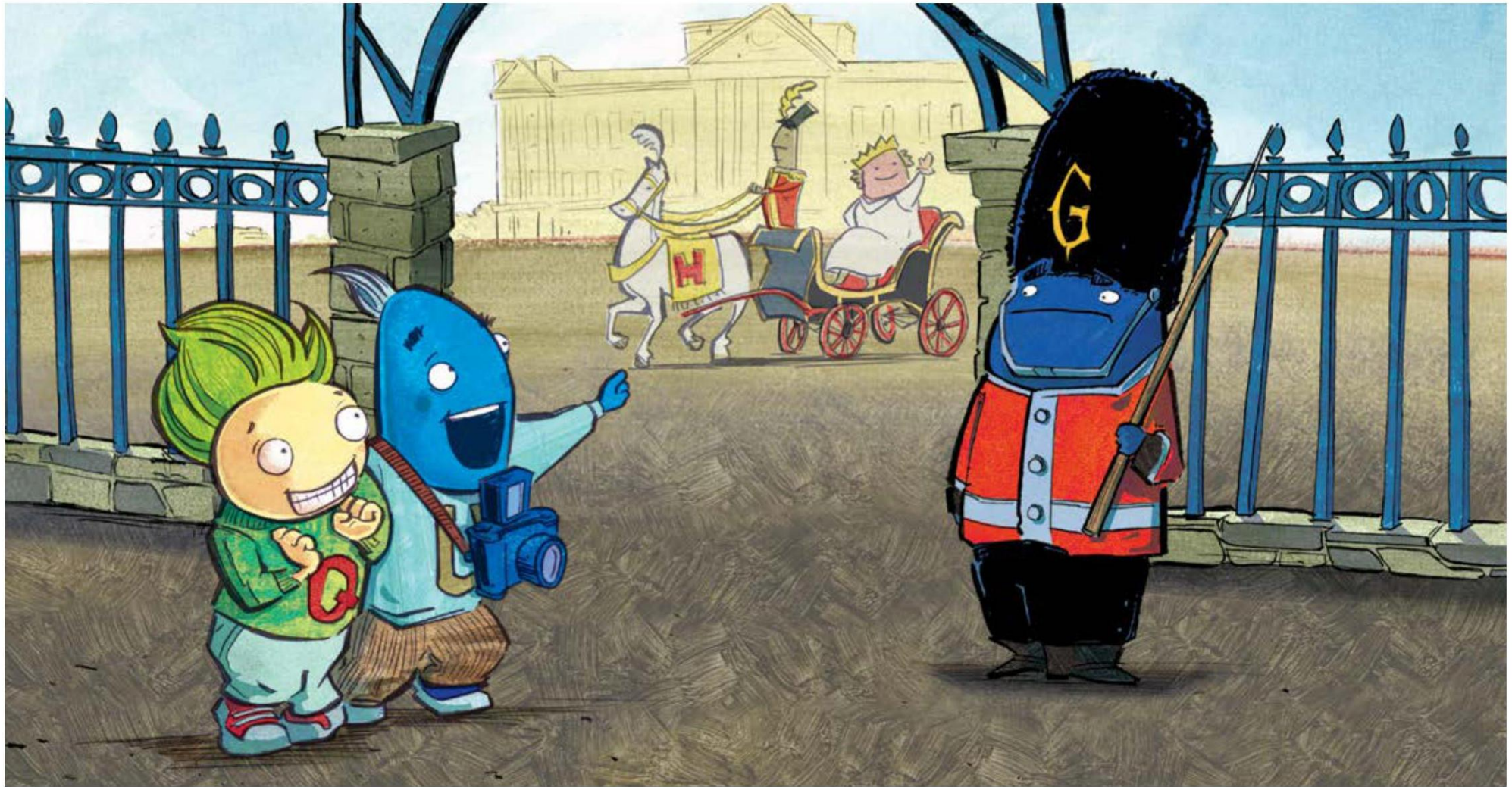
They quilt together in the square.

They squeal together at the queen.



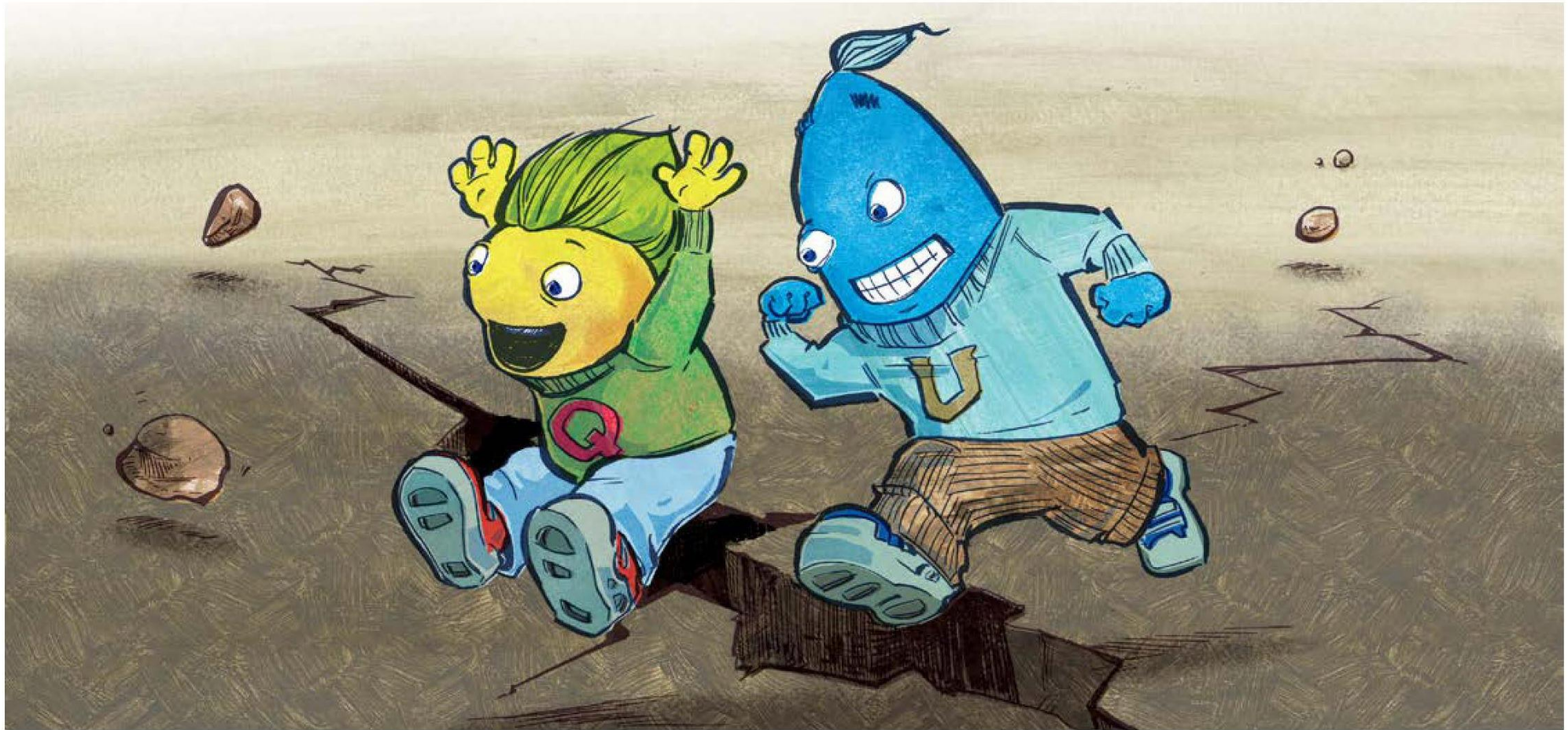
They sigh together during a quiz.
