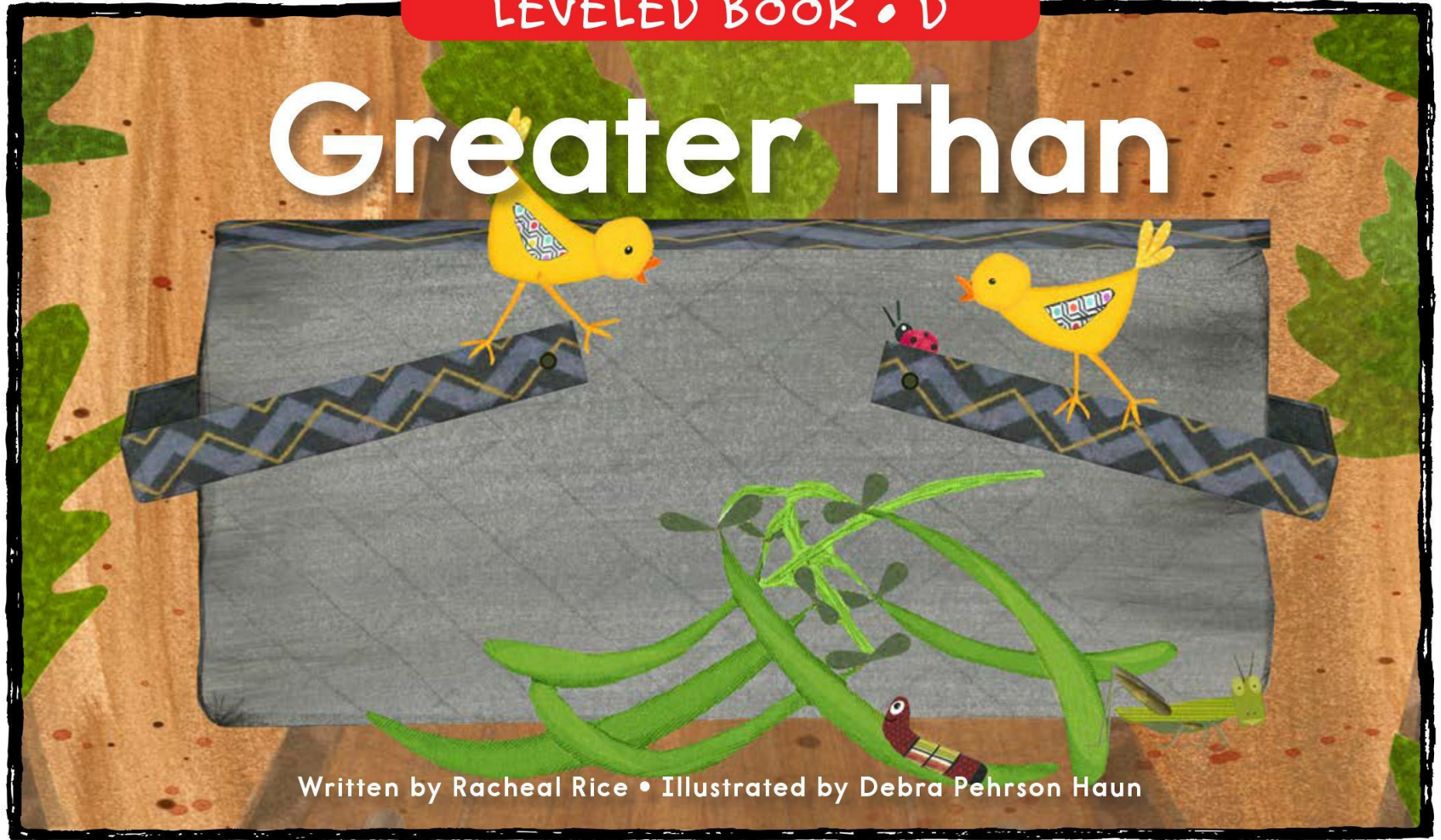

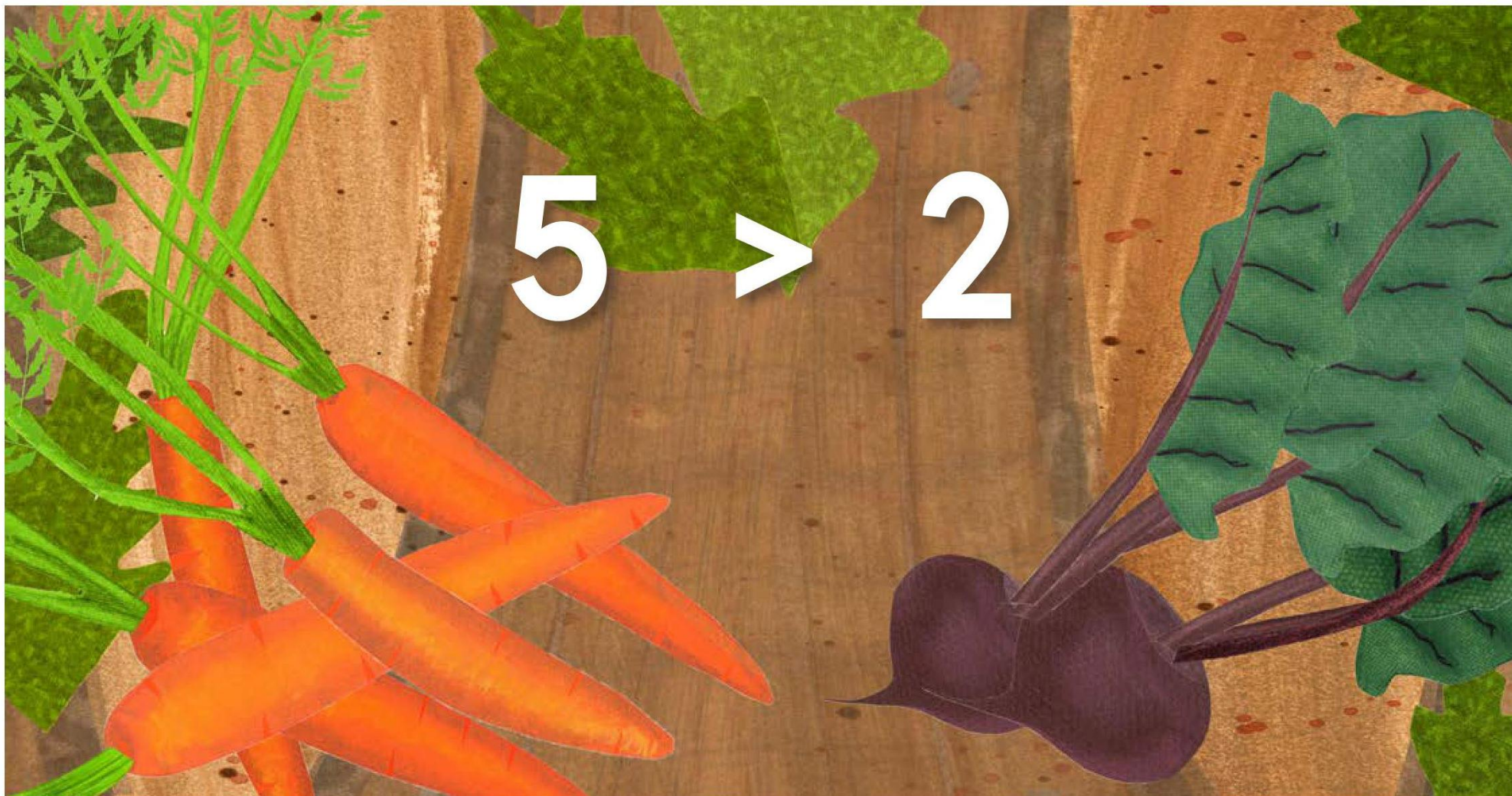

There are five carrots.



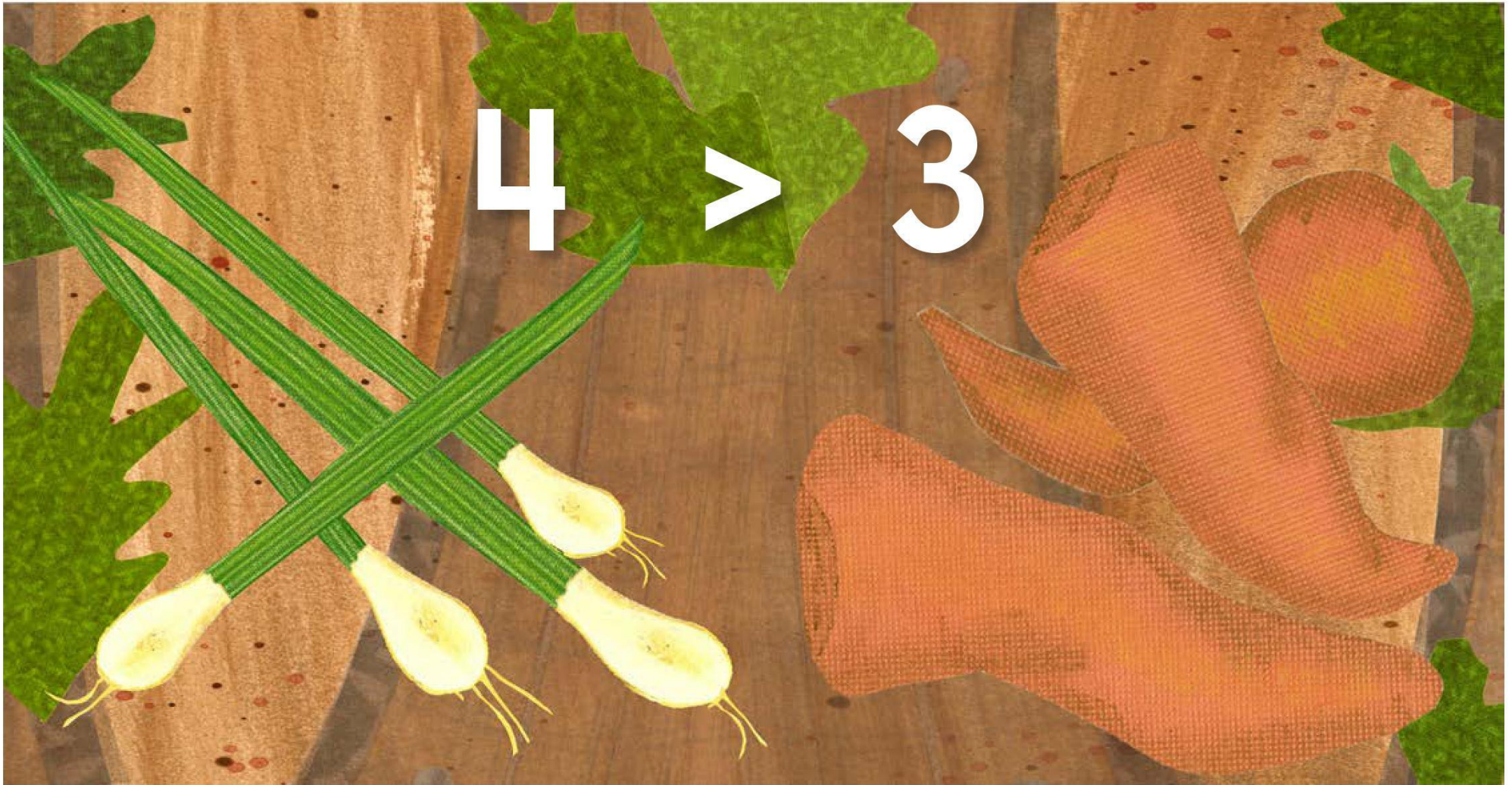
Five is greater than two.

There are four onions.



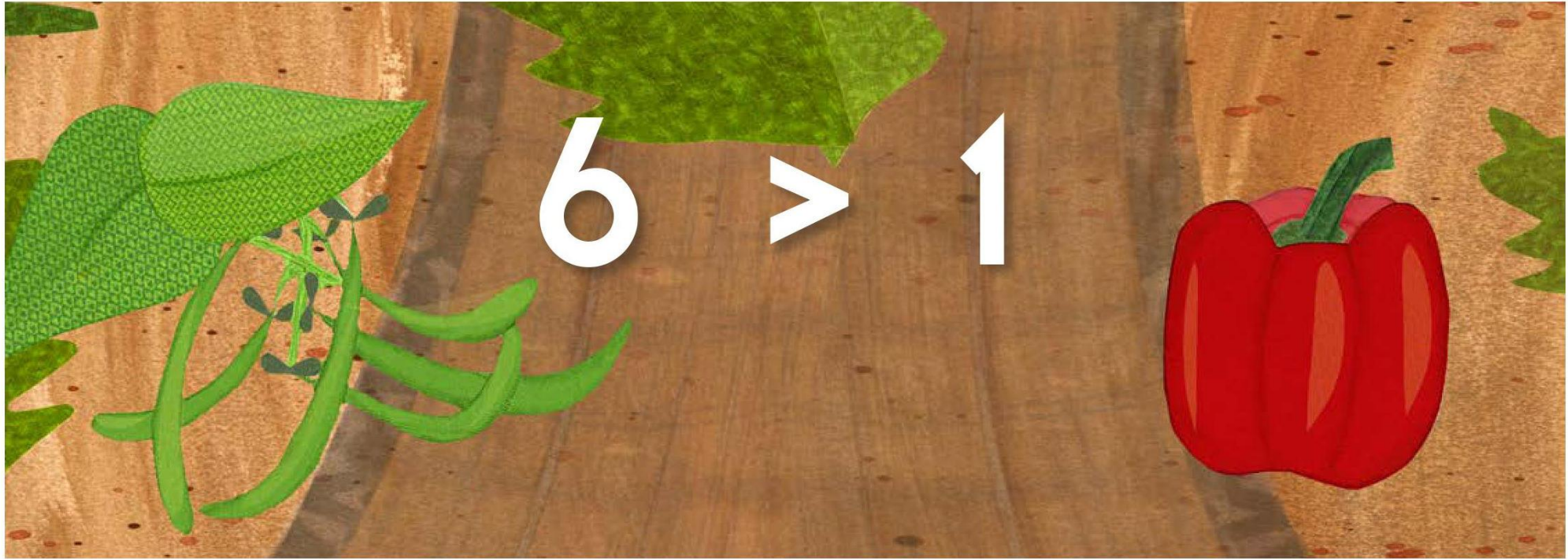
Four is greater than three.
