I do not like to give up.



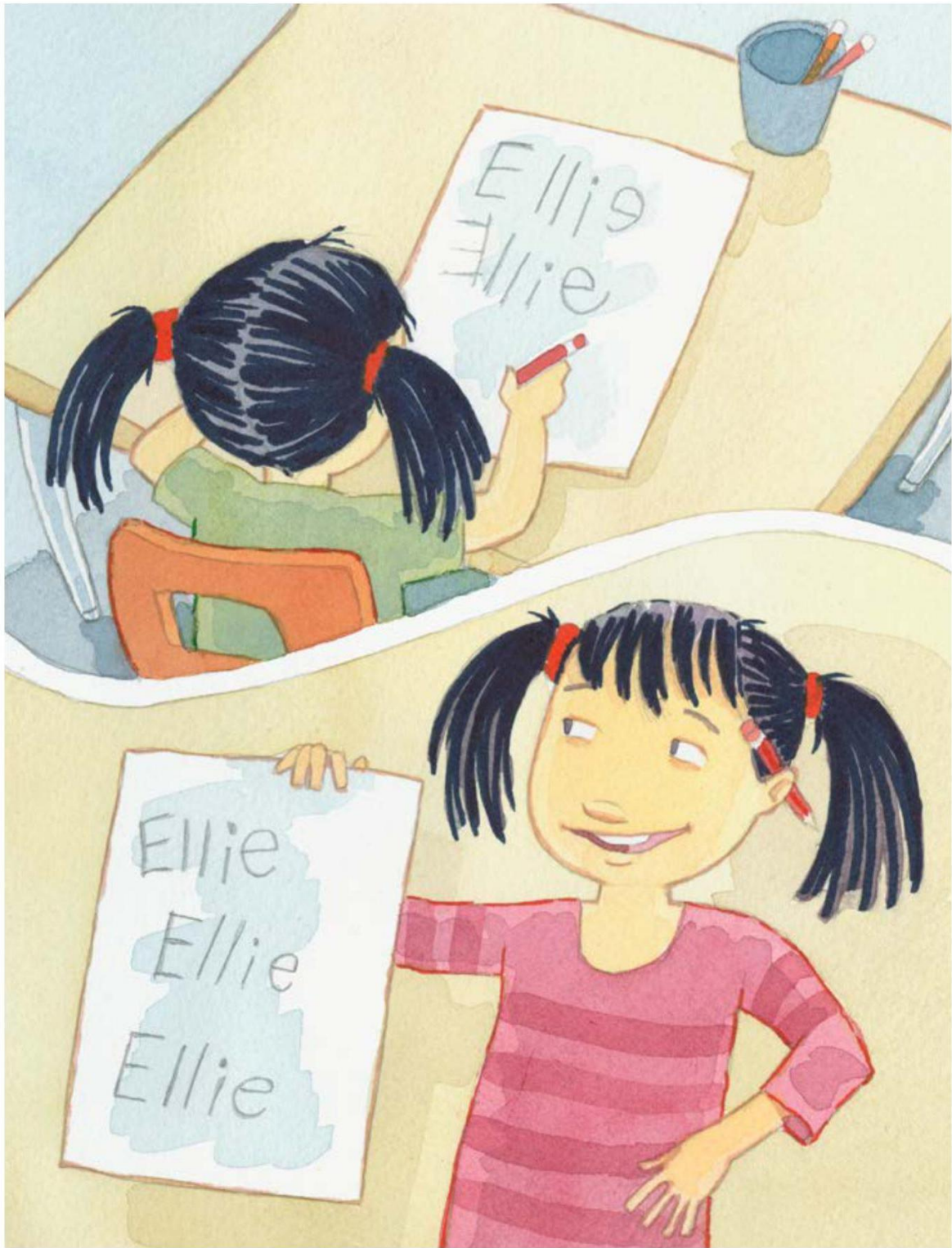
It is important
