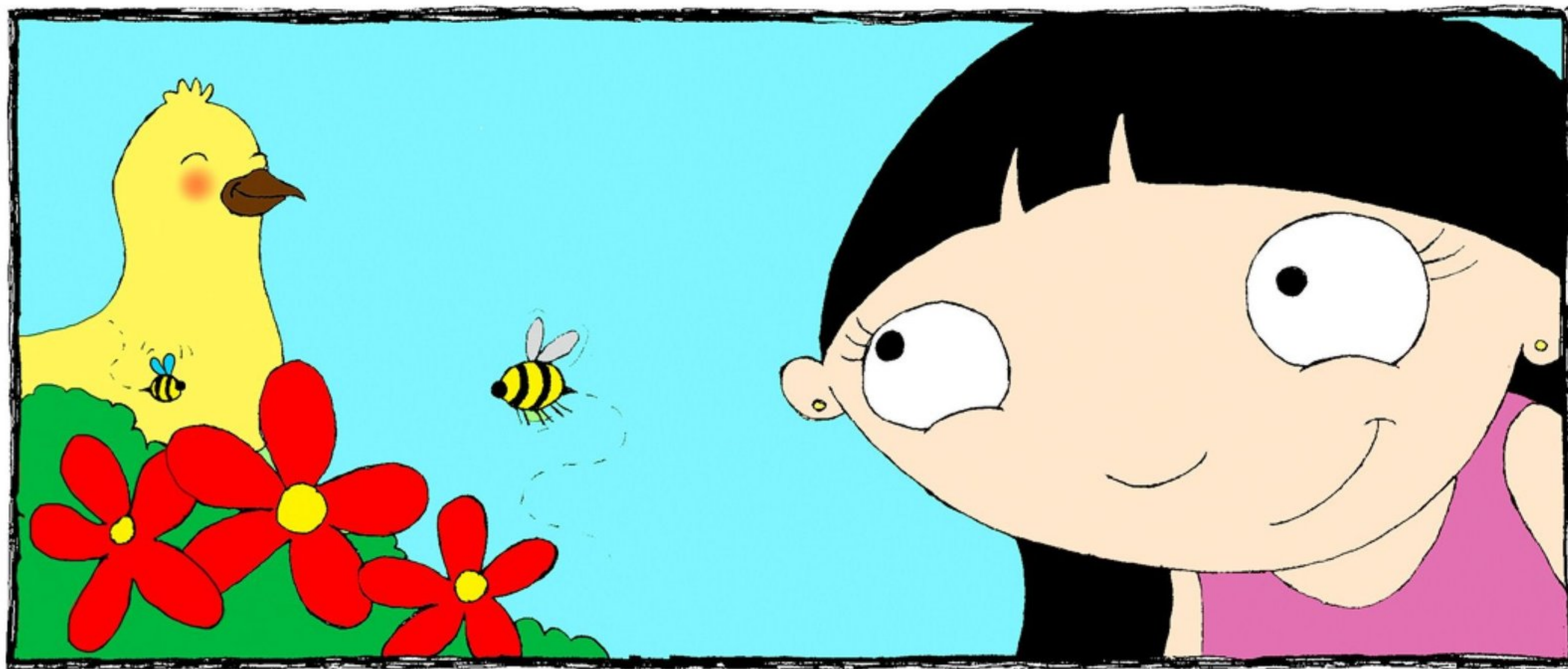


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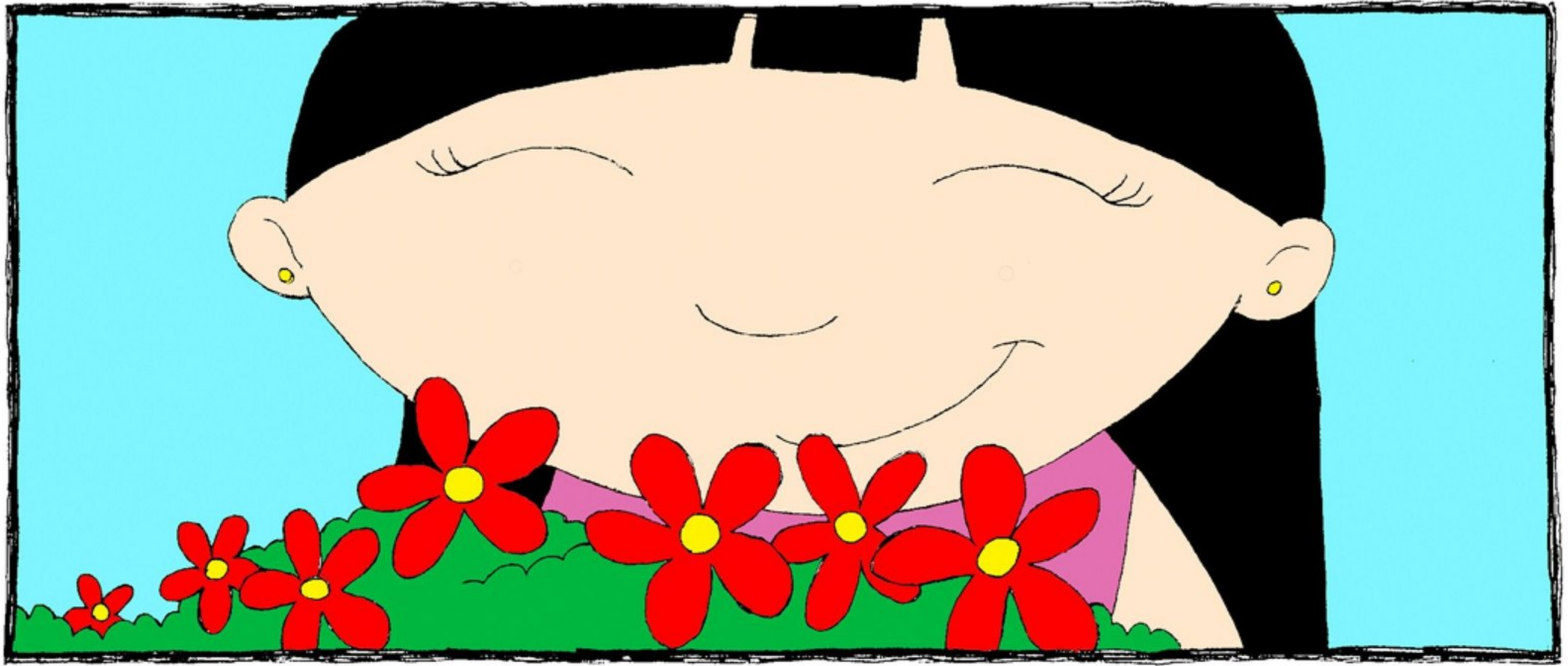
 I like to learn about things.

I use my five senses.



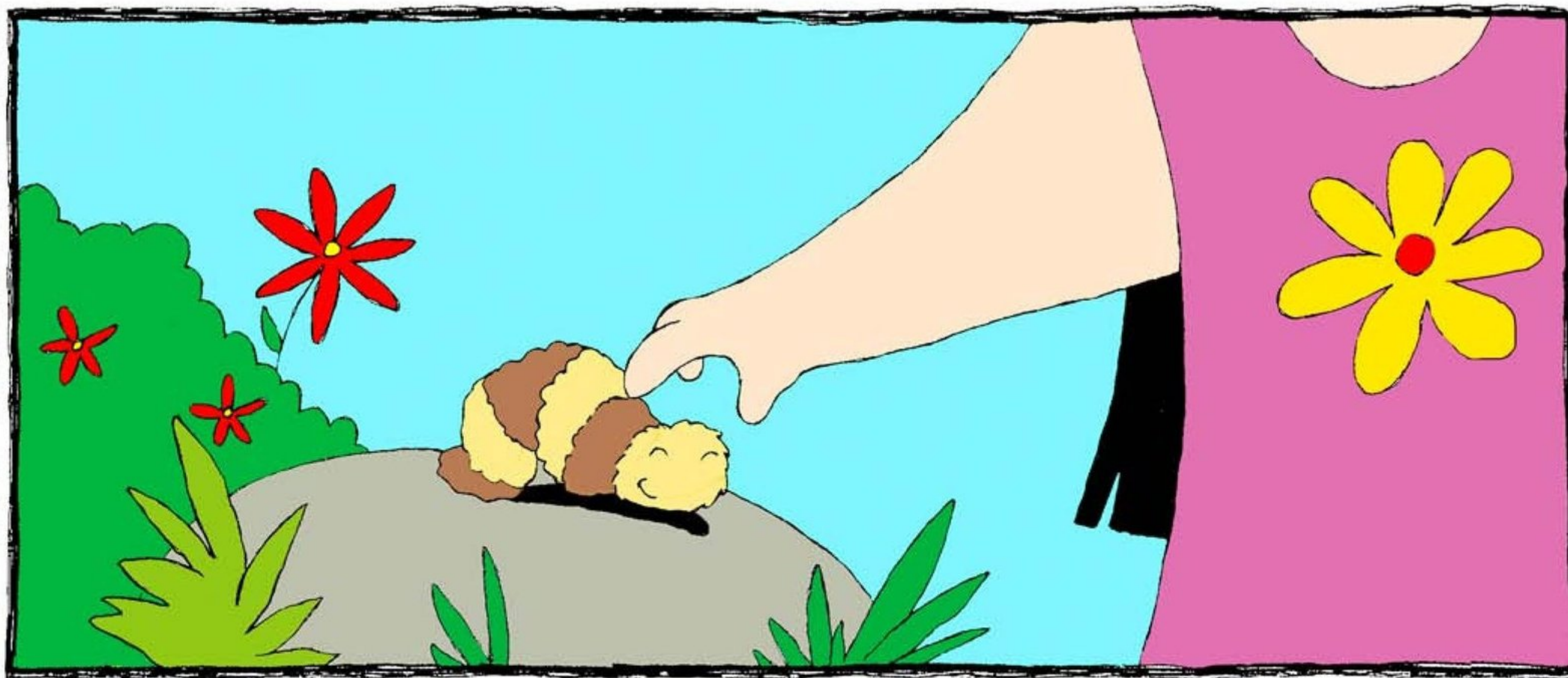
 I use my eyes to see.
I see birds and bees.



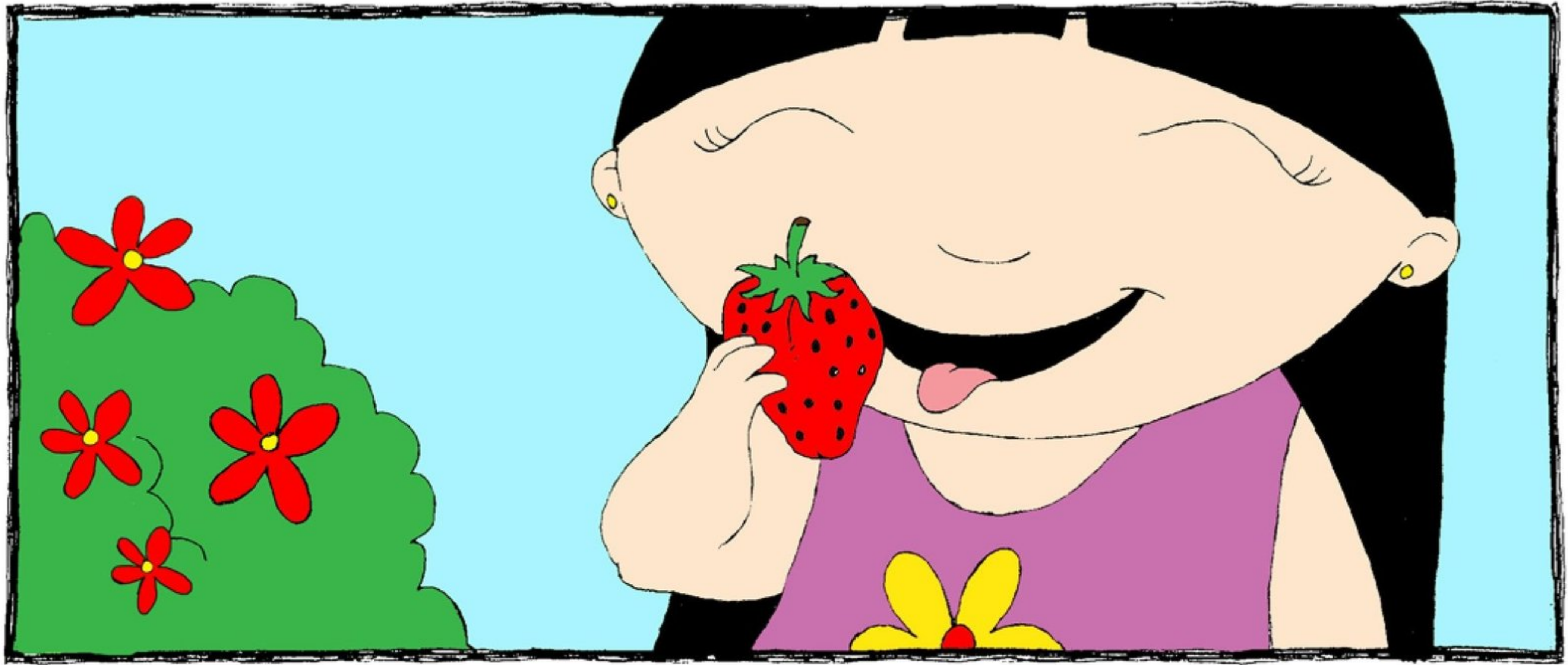
 I use my ears to hear.

I hear bees buzzing.



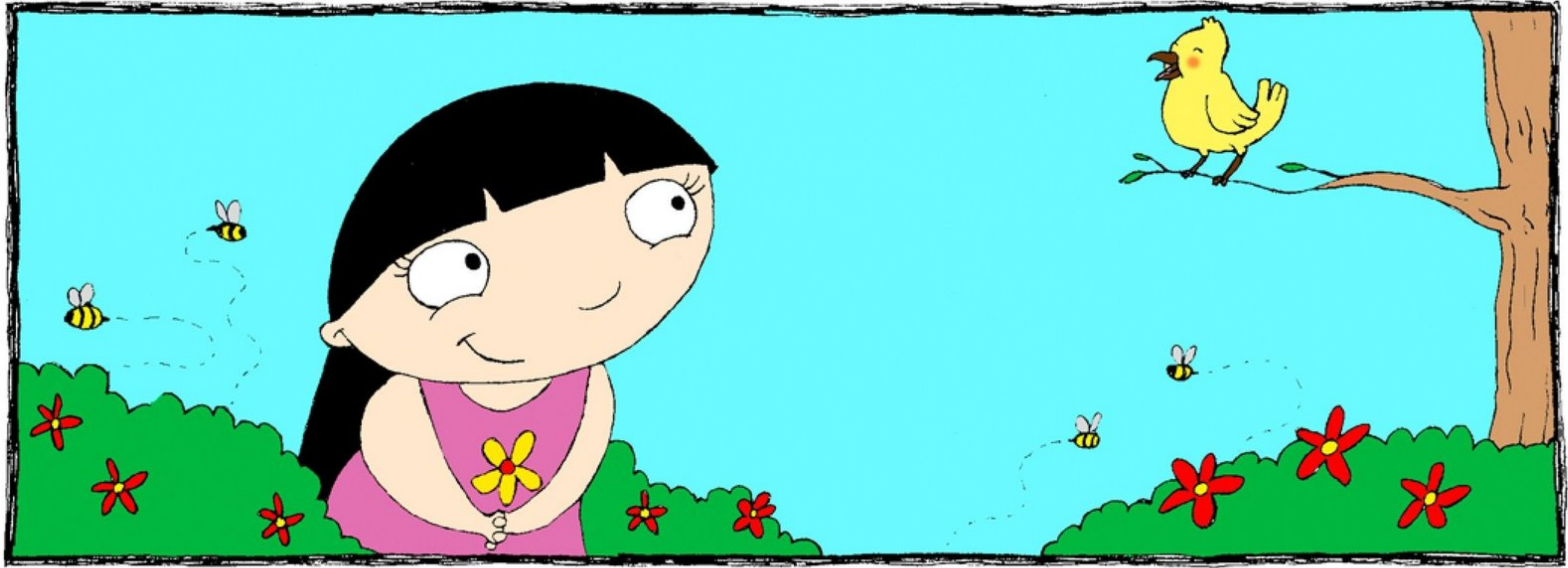
 I use my nose to smell.
I smell pretty flowers.




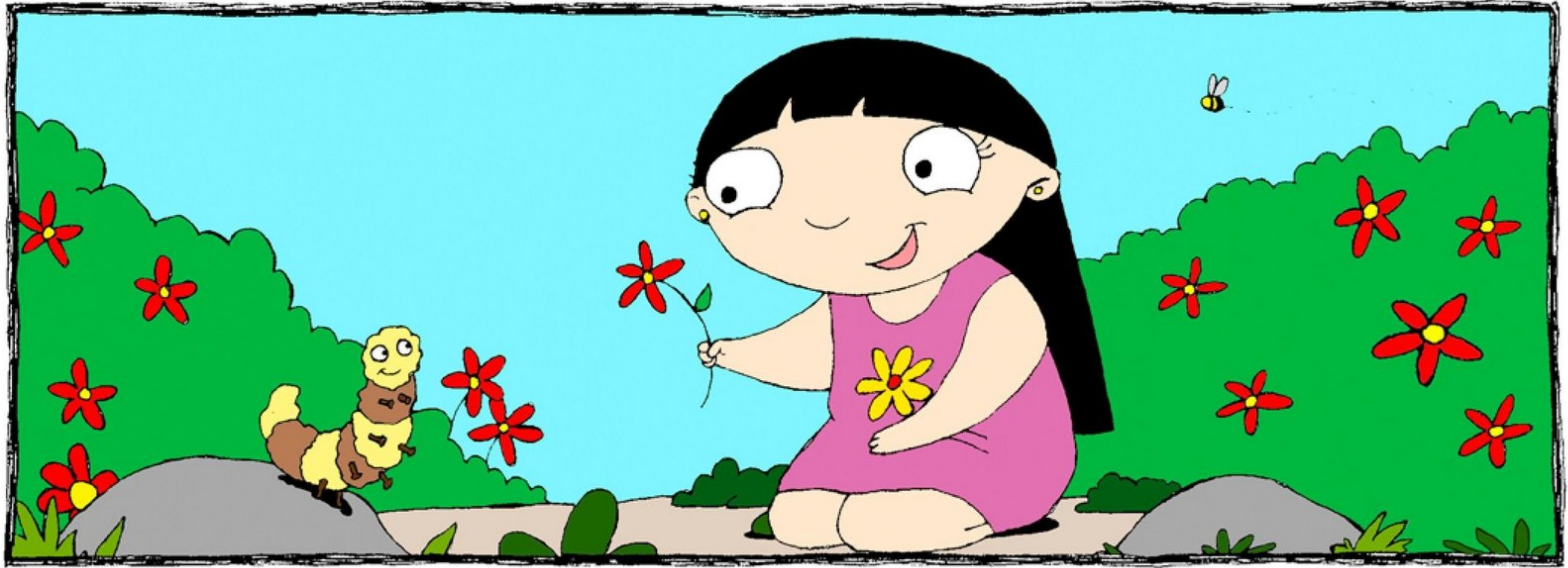
 I use my fingers to touch.
